

To set up your dial up settings on Windows Vista, you'll need to follow a few simple steps.

1. Click on Start, choose 'Connect To' on the right hand column.
2. On the 'Connect To' window, click on the link at the bottom labeled 'Set up a connection or network'.
3. On the 'Choose a Connection Option' window, scroll down and click on 'Set up a dial-up connection'. Click Next.
4. On the 'Type the information...' window, enter the following:
